Re: Town of Pleasant Valley Water District request

Dear Chairman Newton,

The Town of Pleasant Valley is establishing a water district to serve the Hamlet of Pleasant Valley to address contamination issues in the Hamlet. As noted in previous correspondence to the Board, the most feasible means to provide water to the Hamlet would be to acquire water from The Poughkeepsie Joint Water Project Board with delivery through the water main located in the U.S. Route 44 corridor. Proposed connection point would be in the vicinity of the Town of Pleasant Valley/Town of Poughkeepsie boundary line.

Our Map, Plan and Report has documented that we need 60,000 gpd to provide water for the proposed district.

Pleasant Valley has received a WIIA grant to offset the engineering costs of the creation of the water district and has completed SEQRA. Therefore, the Town of Pleasant Valley is requesting to initiate the process of formal approval of an appropriate water sale agreement to acquire such water on terms and conditions that are mutually agreeable.

Approximately six months ago, I appeared before this Board and the Board unanimously supported the Project by informal vote. Accordingly, it is respectfully requested the Board give authority to the Water Plant Administrator and/or a Board Member to open preliminary discussions. I would appreciate your agreement to placing this matter on the agenda of the November 12th Water Board meeting.
